- · Rehabilitation therapists treated COVID+ patients, assisting in their journey to recovery with most patients successfully returning to the community.
- Therapist interactions with patients in nursing facilities helped to combat the detrimental effects of social isolation.
- Therapists filled the gaps for nursing & other staffing shortages.

Despite our ongoing advocacy, rehab therapy continues to be plagued with cuts to reimbursement by CMS, with more expected to impact patients' access to care. We need Congress to step up and block these cuts!

	2013	Another 15% overall reduction due to MPPR  - MPPR further reduced a portion of therapy CPT billing codes from 25% to 50% for 2nd and subsequent therapy codes billed in a day
-	2021	9% cut to rehab therapy reimbursement and 7% cut to SLP services
-	2022	3.75% reduction in therapy reimbursement in addition to a 15% reduction to reimbursement for treatments provided by physical or occupational therapy assistants
	2023	4.47% reduction in therapy reimbursement in addition to 15% therapy assistant reduction
